In the early 2000's, the company acquired a number of brands to complement existing offerings. Adding a half-dozen brands meant taking on a much larger inventory of materials. Sticking with the Right Labeling Solution

MSM Solutions helped Barr Brands develop a label application using two different labels containing a barcode and other pertinent information about the item being labeled. With a barcode label on raw materials, WIP and finished goods, it was important to have the right type of label material, size, and printed format in order to make it easy to scan and fit on shelf tags, boxes, and pallets. Working together, this labeling system aimed to maximize resources and reduce opportunities for error.

Barcode automation helped Barr Brands make big changes in their warehouse and on the production floor. For starters, implementing Zebra handheld mobile computers enabled workers to seamlessly process orders from picking to packing to shipping. Within weeks of deploying the new system, they realized a return on their investment:

Protecting Company Assets with Barcoding Technology

Implementing barcoding technology has simplified the production process as well as the shipping process. With 40-50 trucks picking up shipments every day, it is critical that items are tracked and recorded. Everything gets a barcode label; this includes product on the assembly line and pallets that are being prepared for shipment. The process boils down to this:

- Barcode labels on raw materials (cans, caps or chemicals, for example) are scanned into the system
- Materials are then scanned out of raw materials and are put into production
- Once product is produced and palletized, it's scanned again and placed in finished goods inventory with a barcode identifying the picking location
- When an order is received, product is scanned out of the picking location and prepared for shipment
- Once the pallet of product is placed on the truck for shipment, it is scanned again to confirm that it has been loaded for shipment and the order is invoiced
